2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

The City of Woodland Hills Utah will hold a Municipal General Election on November 2, 2021 for the following offices:

Mayor - 4-year term

2 City Council Seats - 4-year term

Those elected to fill the open positions will take office on January 11, 2022.

This election will be conducted by mail through ranked choice voting. The candidate declaration period will run August 10 through August 17, 2021 from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, excluding Saturday and Sunday.

Candidates for Municipal Office must meet the following requirements:

The person is a United States Citizen

The person will be at least 18 years old by November 2, 2021.

The person is a registered voter in the municipality (City of Woodland Hills, Utah)

The person has been a legal resident of the municipality for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately before November 2, 2021.

The person must not be mentally incompetent, convicted of a felony, convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise, unless their right to hold elective office has been restored.

To file in person:

Prospective candidates must file in person at the Election Office (City Recorder's Office) at 690 South Woodland Hills, Utah during the filing period.

Candidates must file in person unless:

They will be out of the state or country during the entire declaration period. The candidate must send a representative with all of the forms filled out, signed, and notarized. The candidate must be available by video chat while their representative is in the Election Office.

A nomination petition is filed. Contact the Election Office for details.

There is a \$35.00 filing fee. The filing fee is due at the time of declaration.

Please do not wait until the last minute to file. The doors close promptly at 3:00 PM on August 17.

IMPORTANT 2021 DATES TO REMEMBER

No primary election will be held this year because the city has opted to run the election through ranked choice voting.

August 10-17: Declaration of Candidacy Filing Period

August 18-30: Anyone wishing to file as a write-in candidate can do so August 18-30, by 5:00 PM. Please contact the City of Woodland Hills City Office at 801.423.3900 to make an appointment.

October 3: The last day a resident can establish residency and vote in the City of Woodland Hills 2021 General Election

October 11: Ballots will be mailed to registered voters. If you have not received your ballot by October 18, please contact the Utah County Elections Office at 801.851.81125. (Once received, ballots can be dropped in the ballot drop boxes at any ballot drop box in Utah County.)

October 27- November 1: Early voting period. Anyone who has not registered to vote may register to vote and vote during the early voting period. At the Utah County Elections Office, 100 E. Center Street, Room 3100, Provo, Utah

October 22: The last day the county will accept voter registrations for the 2021 General Election. To register to vote online go to <u>www.vote.utah.gov</u>.

October 28: Last day to submit Military and Overseas voter registrations. Military and overseas voters please go to the following website for further information on registering and voting. <u>https://voteinfo.utah.gov/military-and-overseas-voters/</u>

November 1: The last day to mail your ballot. The ballot envelope must be postmarked on or before this date.

November 2: Election Day. Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. You may pick up a ballot or get election help at any Vote Center in the county. Please check the <u>Utah County website</u> for locations.

November 16: Canvass and Certification of election results

January 11, 2021: Newly-elected Mayor and Councilmembers are sworn in and take office.
