

TED TALK - CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING

OVER THE YEAR AND A HALF, AT THE DIRECTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, OUR CITY HAS BEEN DOING SIGNIFICANT AMOUNTS OF INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING TO EVALUATE THE CITY'S INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS AND THE BEST WAY TO BUDGET AND EXECUTE THE PROJECTS. THE DEVELOPMENT OF THESE PLANS HELPS US BETTER UNDERSTAND THE CITY'S INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS AND COSTS, THIS HAS BEEN A BIG PART OF THE DISCUSSION WHILE WORKING ON THE UPCOMING YEAR'S FISCAL BUDGET. THE MAJOR INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS INCLUDE REPAIRING AND PRESERVING OUR ROADS (PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECTS). COMPLETING AND UPGRADING OUR WELL, ADDITIONAL WATER STORAGE, REPLACING AGED WATERLINES THAT HAVE REACHED THEIR LIFE EXPECTANCY, AND CONTROLLING OUR STORMWATER RUNOFF THAT IMPACTS BOTH OUR CITY AND THE DOWNHILL CITIES AND COUNTY PROPERTIES. THESE PLANS IDENTIFY SEVERAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS, PRIORITIZES THEM, AND PROVIDES ESTIMATED BUDGETS AND SCHEDULES FOR ACCOMPLISHING THESE PROJECTS OVER THE NEXT 6-10 YEARS AS BUDGET ALLOWS. ONE OF THESE PROJECTS, OUR WELL COMPLETION AND UPGRADE, IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION, AND ONE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, POSSIBLY TWO, ARE PLANNED TO BE COMPLETED THIS YEAR. THE PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECTS FOR THIS YEAR INCLUDE OVER 50 PERCENT OF THE 17 MILES OF ROADS IN OUR CITY. THE BUDGET FOR THIS YEAR'S PROJECTS, IN PART, INCLUDES MONEY THAT HAS BEEN SAVED BY OUR CITY TO COMPLETE THEM. IN ADDITION TO THE PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECTS. THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY FIVE AND A HALF MILES OF WATERLINES THAT HAVE REACHED THEIR LIFE AND ARE READY TO BE REPLACED, AND HALF A DOZEN STORMWATER RUNOFF PROJECTS THAT SHOULD BE COMPLETED TO BETTER CONTROL OUR RUNOFF. THESE INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL PROJECTS ARE ESTIMATED TO HAVE AN APPROXIMATE COST OF TEN MILLION DOLLARS. THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THIS INFORMATION IS TO GIVE A PARTIAL PERSPECTIVE OF WHAT THE CITY COUNCIL IS CONSIDERING WHEN HAVING BUDGET DISCUSSIONS IN THE UPCOMING MEETINGS. WE ARE APPROACHING THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR. ENDING JUNE 30, 2025. AND STARTING A NEW FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1. THE CITY COUNCIL HAS HAD SEVERAL BUDGET MEETINGS AND HELD SEVERAL PUBLIC HEARINGS TO TAKE PUBLIC INPUT AS TO OUR UPCOMING BUDGET FOR THE YEAR AHEAD. SAD TO SAY THERE HAS BEEN SCANT PARTICIPATION BY CITY RESIDENTS IN THESE PUBLIC HEARINGS, BOTH TO LEARN HOW OUR MONEY IS BEING SPENT AND WHAT THE CITY COUNCIL IS PROPOSING FOR OUR COMING YEAR'S BUDGET, I KNOW THAT OUR CITY COUNCIL IS VERY CONCERNED ABOUT ANY PROPERTY TAX INCREASES THAT WE AS RESIDENTS WILL HAVE TO INCUR IN ORDER TO MEET OUR BUDGET DEMANDS IN THE COMING YEAR. HOWEVER, YOU RESIDENTS SEEM TO BE RATHER NOT INTERESTED AS FEWER THAN 3 PEOPLE HAVE ATTENDED THESE CITY COUNCIL BUDGET HEARINGS. IF YOU WANT TO CATCH UP. YOU SHOULD CONTACT ONE OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS AND TAKE YOUR OUESTIONS TO THEM ABOUT THE BUDGET. YOU CAN FIND ANY OF THEIR NAMES ON THE CITY WEB SITE AND REACH OUT TO THEM DIRECTLY. AT THE PRESENT TIME THE COMING YEAR'S BUDGET IS ONLY TENTATIVE AND HAS NOT BEEN FINALIZED YET. THERE IS A TRUTH IN TAXATION TOWN HALL MEETING THAT WILL BE HELD ON AUGUST 12 AT 6PM AT THE CITY CENTER WHERE MORE BUDGET DETAILS WILL BE SHARED AND I WOULD ENCOURAGE ALL RESIDENTS IN THE CITY TO ATTEND. IT IS OUR MONEY THAT IS BEING SPENT.
