


### Ordinance 2026-11

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR THE EMPLOYEES, EXECUTIVE OFFICERS, AND ELECTED OFFICIALS OF WOODLAND HILLS, UTAH, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of [Name of Municipality], Utah, is required by [Utah Code § 10-3-818](#) to establish by ordinance the compensation of all municipal officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, a tentative budget and proposed compensation schedule for Fiscal Year 2027 have been prepared and reviewed by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to public notice duly given, a public hearing was held on June 9<sup>th</sup> 2026, at the regular meeting place of the City Council to receive public comment regarding the proposed adjustments to the compensation schedules for all municipal positions, executive officials, and elected officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the proposed compensation adjustments are reasonable, necessary to maintain qualified personnel, and in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the city.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOODLAND HILLS, UTAH:**

**SECTION 1: COMPENSATION FOR SALARIED, GENERAL AND HOURLY MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES**

Effective July 1, 2026, the compensation schedules for all full-time and part-time municipal positions are attached hereto as "Exhibit A"

- Community Development Director / Public Works Director / Fire Chief
- City Recorder
- City Treasurer
- Public Works Technician

**SECTION 2: COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS**

Effective July 1, 2026, the compensation for the elected officials of the municipality is hereby established as follows:

- Mayor: \$7200 annually
- City Council Members: \$3600 annually

**SECTION 3: REPEALER**

All prior ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY**

If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and posting/publication as required by law.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**
