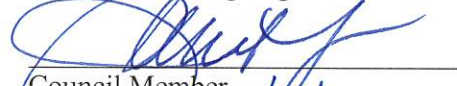

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-45

A RESOLUTION DISSOLVING THE WOODLAND HILLS CITY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Woodland Hills City Council previously established the Community Development Committee to assist the City in reviewing and providing input on matters related to community planning, development, and other matters assigned by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Committee provided valuable assistance and recommendations during the preparation and review of the City's General Plan and Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the work assigned to the Community Development Committee has been completed and that the continued operation of the Committee is no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formally dissolve the Community Development Committee and express its appreciation to the individuals who served on the Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOODLAND HILLS CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. DISSOLUTION OF COMMITTEE.

The Woodland Hills City Community Development Committee is hereby dissolved, effective upon the adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENTS.

All appointments to the Community Development Committee shall terminate upon the effective date of this Resolution. No further meetings, reports, recommendations, or other actions shall be required of the Committee.

SECTION 3. RECORDS AND MATERIALS.

Any records, reports, recommendations, meeting materials, or other documents maintained by or on behalf of the Community Development Committee shall be delivered to the City Recorder and retained in accordance with applicable records-retention requirements.

SECTION 4. APPRECIATION FOR SERVICE.

The City Council expresses its sincere appreciation to each member of the Community Development Committee for their time, service, and assistance in the development and review of the City's General Plan and Strategic Plan.

SECTION 5. PRIOR ACTIONS.

All prior resolutions, motions, appointments, or other City actions establishing or continuing the Community

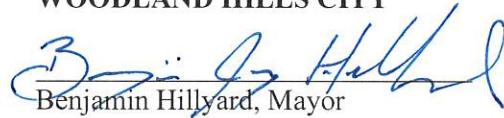
Development Committee are hereby rescinded or superseded to the extent they are inconsistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

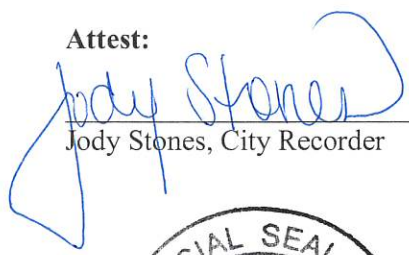
This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
