## City Government

- Construction on Woodland Hills Drive is scheduled to commence this year at the first of June. This should avoid problems with the school buses and detour routes. We ask all citizens to please observe the detours (as inconvenient as they may be). Traffic through the detour zone last year played a significant role in delaying the project. We are trying to determine if there are enough funds to increase the size of the parking lot at the City Center when we complete the road this year.
- Corbett Stephens is working with the City Engineers to complete design of the pump house for our new well. We hope to have it completed by the time road construction begins.
- We are currently receiving bids for garbage collection. Due to increased costs from the Solid Waste District, garbage collection rates will likely increase. Additionally, the Council is considering the benefits and costs of curbside recycling.

This could be lessened if we receive some timely rains; however, we cannot count on this. With the lack of snow we have on the ground it will be a good year to work on making your property fire wise. Pull out the dead and any unwanted oak trees. Keep in mind that if you remove the oak trees that are around the maple trees, then the maples will really take off.

We have two events on the horizon. The first is the expo and will be held in May. This is a great time to get the kids and grandkids up to the station for an up-close

look at the fire and medical equipment. Last year we had the Air-Med helicopter land in the upper parking lot. (more to come on this)

The other is the chipper day. We may start piling brush on April 25th and the chipper day will be on May 11th. This will give everyone 3 weekends to pull brush to the road.

**IMPORTANT:** Due to the dry winter we have had, early piles will NOT be allowed. You will receive a letter asking you to remove them or the City will remove them at the owner's expense. Thank you for your cooperation on this.

As we move on into Spring, please take some time to go around your house and find those areas that trap the leaves and trash. These areas will also be where embers may end up creating an issue should there be a fire. Rain gutters are another area that should be cleaned out each spring. With the great weather we are having, now is a good time to take care of these small but very important details.

Please have a safe and enjoyable Spring and remember to dial 911 if you see or smell smoke.
