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On January 20<sup>th</sup>, the City of Woodland Hills, the Woodland Hills Fire Department, Utah Dept. of Natural Resources and County Fire held the second of a series of meetings in regards to the CWPP (Community Wildfire Protection Plan). I would like to thank those who attended the first two meetings. It was a great turnout loaded with energy, ideas, and input. We had approximately 50 who attended the first meeting and around 45 on the second. During the second meeting the attendees were able to get Part 2 of the CWPP successfully filled out. It has been very rewarding to witness residents talking through the different sections and coming up with solutions that will make our common goal a reality — **"Woodland Hills, A Safer Place to Live"**.

The CWPP is a prime example of what our community is capable of doing when we have a common goal. This plan will ultimately be about "Neighbors helping Neighbors, Friends helping Friends". As a part of this plan we will have wood chipper days that will be funded by state and federal grant money.

**Our next meeting is scheduled for February 3rd at 7:00 pm at the Woodland Hills Fire Station.** I will continue to provide updates as the CWPP moves along that will include chipper dates and available assistance to those that need help. # Woodland Hills Fire Department Annual Report –2010

Following is the 2010 Annual Report for the Woodland Hills Fire Department. At the end of 2010, there were 35 members consisting of 11 fire, 6 medical, 14 trained for both fire and medical and 4 serving in Auxiliary positions. Among those 35 members, there were a total of 109 certifications:

We had a total of 44 calls – 25 of those calls were fire related and 19 were medical related. A total of 389 hours were voluntarily spent by the members of the department on calls. Many hours have been volunteered in other areas – 245 in brush clearing, 202 on Woodland Hills Days, 76 on the Spring Expo and 46 working with schools and youth groups. There have been 4,576 hours spent in training, 2,342 hours spent in office/administrative areas, 288 hours in maintenance, 249 hours in Officers meetings and 579 in miscellaneous areas. The total hours volunteered by the members of the Fire Department was 8,992.

We received a total of \$19,332 in government grant money that was earmarked for specific items and another \$10,320 worth of items that were donated by other departments, businesses or individuals. The grant money that was received requires a certain percentage of the total amount to be matched by either City funds or non-cash “in-kind” contributions which can be provided by individuals volunteering their time. In 2010, the government valued in-kind work at \$20.85/hr, and with the 8,992 hours volunteered by the Fire Department, the total amount of in-kind contributions is valued at \$187,483.20.

As members of the Woodland Hills Fire Department and as residents of Woodland Hills, we have the opportunity of helping our neighbors and friends in an emergency situation. We do our best in preparing to be ready for those events. We feel blessed to have so many qualified and caring people as members of our department. We are always looking for individuals who would like to join us in our cause of helping Woodland Hills be a safer place to live.
