# Salem Junior High School

In March the Salem Junior High PTA accepted the designation to raise funds for a marquee at the school. Utah Community Credit Union made that task much easier by donating a beautiful marquee. Thank you UCCU and President Jeff Sermon and thank you Kirk and Angela Rogers for your help!

Immediately after receiving the marquee, the installation and refurbishment processes began. The sign was personalized with the school logo and colors and completed in time for the school's ribbon cutting in August.
